# **How the Program Works**

- Donations of accepted household items and furnishings are received at the *Home to Home* location.
- Families or individuals must be referred to the *Home to Home Project* by the designated non-profit agencies in our collaborative.
- A representative of the referring non-profit agency and the prospective recipient call a *Home to Home* staff member to arrange an appointment.
- Needed items are picked up by the non-profit agency's representative with or without the client.

## **How the Program Works**

- There are no financial qualifications, no membership requirements, and no paperwork to fill out in order to receive food. All are welcome and everyone will be served regardless of religion, race, ethnicity, or age.
- Our weekly distribution takes place every Wednesday from 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm at 1020 Hwy 71 NE (across from the Flags of Honor) in Willmar. People are encouraged to bring their own box, tote, or bag to carry home their allotted items.
- A \$1.00 donation per family is required to help offset our truck fuel costs and maintenance.

## How can I help?

- Donate gently used or new household items including furniture, kitchen necessities, bath towels, and bedding of all sizes.
- Donate zip-seal bags of all sizes. They are used to put bulk foods into family sized portions.
- Donate money to provide gas. Our truck goes to the Twin Cities weekly to pick up food for *Hope* for Our City.
- Donate money that will be used to purchase dressers from Slumberland.
- Organize a product drive. Contact us to see what kind of items are in greatest need.
